## **Buy Art-Shenzhen Dafen Oil Painting Village**

### **Let A Hundred Sunflowers Bloom**

After television and underwear, China price is reshaping the oil painting industry.

"Zhang Libing has painted more van Goghs than van Gogh ever did," the *New York Times* reported. "At 26, Mr. Zhang estimates that he has painted up to 20,000 copies of van Gogh's works in a paint-spattered third-floor garret here where freshly washed socks and freshly painted canvases dry side-by-side on the balcony."

20,000 copies? Assuming that Mr Zhang has started painting at 18 and he paints everyday in eight years, he must have produced about seven van Goghs each day?

Mr Zhang works in a painting store in Dafen Oil Painting Village in Buji, Longgang, Shenzhen, just across the border from Hong Kong. There are more than a dozen blocks of paintings stores with studios upstairs. He earns less than \$200 a month, plus modest room and board.

Seeing the photos in NYT readers may agree that the quality of the mass production of van Goghs is really impressive. I will visit Dafen to see "Vincent van Gogh meets Henry Ford" in Shenzhen.
